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BERNINA WEEKEND

In total, six AACZ members participated in the Bernina weekend, which I organized in July 2017. Most of us arrived on Saturday morning at the Luftseilbahn Corvatsch. The weather was cloudy but fine. We started our tour by following the crest line from the station towards the South, passing through Piz Murtel, Piz Corvatsch (3,451m) and Lej Sgrischus. Apart from a bit of walking on ice at the beginning, the climbing was rock all the way with a gorgeous view on both sides of the valley. We finished the route by the end of the afternoon at the pass of Fuorcla Fex-Roseg and went down towards the Coaz Hut. The hut is located on a beautiful

spot at the end of the Roseg glacier. Unfortunately the glacier has retreated a lot in the last decades. The next day was sunny but because of the lack of snow on the glacier, we decided to do an easy route to avoid crevasses: four of us went to La Muongia (3,415m) while two others did Il Chapütschin (3,386m), a glacier route that ends with the climb of a stony summit. Still fresh, after La Muongia the team of four then also climbed Il Chapütschin and followed the ridge before taking a short cut to descend into the valley.
