Between 27.12.2000 and 6.1.2001 the Foundation for Young Swiss Abroad (SJAS) is again organising two New Year ski camps. As before, they will be held in Splügen (GR) and Engelberg (OW).

The camps are organised and accompanied by experienced teams of camp leaders. The cost is CHF 800 per child (incl. travel from the Swiss border, ski pass, board and lodging). The SJAS operates a fund which allows this price to be reduced if it exceeds a family's budget. An application form for a price subsidy can be ordered when registering for the camp. In special cases a contribution is also made

towards the cost of travel to Switzerland.

A special offer is available for children born in 1986 and 1987. Between ten and twelve children of this age will be able to join hundreds of other children from all over Switzerland for the large Swiss Ski Association camp in Lenk (BE) (1.1.–8.1. 2001) at no cost.
