

RULES OF THE CIRCULATING LIBRARY OF THE SWISS BENIVOLENT SOCIETY.

Our newly formed Circulating Library is now open to all financial members of the Society. The following rules must be observed :-

Relating to Books :

- A list of books may be obtained from the Secretary who is also acting as Librarian.
- Only financial members of the Society are entitled to take part in this scheme. Lending of books or papers to non-members is strictly prohibited.
- Prospective members of the Library must pay 2/6d (two shillings and six pence) deposit to the Secretary as a guarantee for the good care and safe return of the books. These deposits will be held by the Society as long as the respective members wish to take part in the Library scheme. deposits shall be returned to members wishing to terminate their connection with the Library.
- 4. Postage must be defrayed by the members, by enclosing 3d. stamps with each book when returning.
