"Interieur 74" In Geneva

The first International Exhibition of Furniture and Interior Decoration, "Interieur 74", is being held in the Geneva Exhibitions Palace from April 24 to May 4 this year. The purpose of this trade fair is to present a new conception of the art of living. Interior decorators, interior architects and designers of world repute from Germany, Canada, Denmark, Spain, Finland, France, Great Britain, Italy, Sweden, the U.S.A. and Switzerland will be displaying a wide range of contemporary and period furnishing schemes to both professionals and the general public. Manufacturers, importers and retailers will offer visitors the possibility of solving all their interior decorating problems. Over an area of nearly 16,000 sq.m (175,000 sq. ft.), "Interieur 74" will be displaying among other things professional furniture, period or rustic furniture, wall and floor coverings, wall-to-wall carpeting, carpets and fabrics. It will also feature an international display of the prototypes of the year in the way of interior decoration, as well as the objects and furniture created by sculptors, together with wallpaper, tapestry, floral art, etc.—(SODT).
