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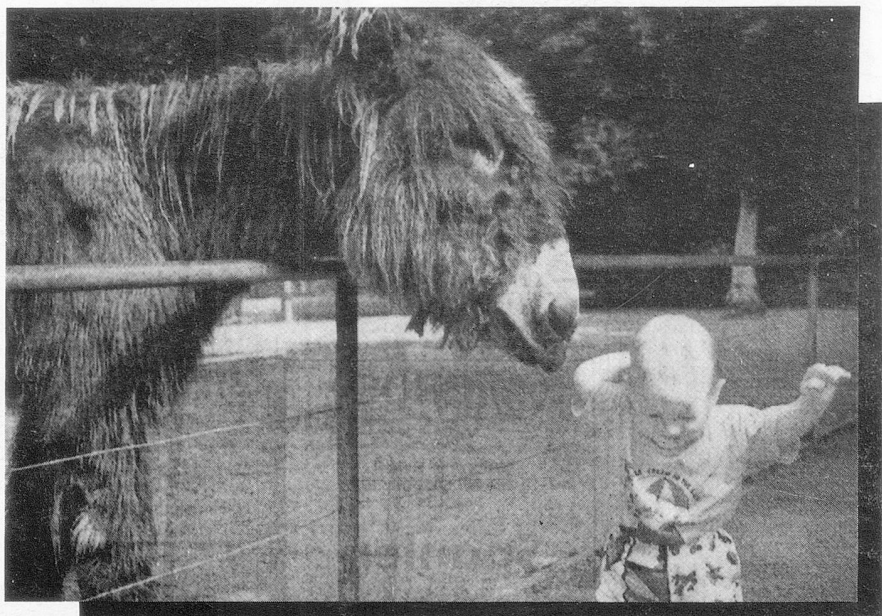


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GIANT DONKEY

This rare giant donkey is a new arrival at the Bemese Zoo of Dählhölzli. There are only about 100 of these animals left in the world. This giant long-haired donkey is of a very docile nature, unusual as far as donkeys go, and originates from the Poitou region of France. Measuring up to 1.5m at shoulder height, the "Poitou" donkey is by far the largest donkey in the world.
