AND DO YOU RECOGNISE HIM?

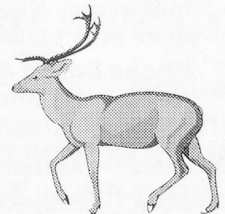
This true sweet water captain is no other than Federal Councillor Jean-Pascal DELAMURAZ sailing his beloved boat on Lake Geneva.
