21-24 July, 1928.

The Swiss Colony in London will be represented in Lucerne by the team of the Swiss Gymnastic Society composed of 12 men, and in order to give the Colony at large and especially lovers of Gymnastics, an opportunity to see the work the team has to perform in Lucerne and the high standard required at these Great Swiss Competitions, a complete performance of the various exercises, with the obvious exception of the Horse and Long Jump, will be given at the Union Helvetia Club, 1, Gerrard Place, on Sunday, the 7th July, 1928, and on the Sports Ground of the Swiss Bank Corporation at Preston Road on the following Sunday, the 14th July, 1928.

The Swiss Gymnastic Society wishes to thank publicly the many supporters and most generous donors for their magnificent financial help to render possible the trip to Lucerne. The Society is also most grateful to the Sports Club of the Swiss Bank Corporation, who so kindly put their ground at the disposal of the team for training purposes.

Any members of the Swiss Colony in London who wish to accompany the Gymnastic Party, leaving London on Friday, 20th July, 1928 at 8 p.m. from Victoria can do so on advantageous terms by applying to any member of the Swiss Gymnastic Society.
