GREAT PATRIOTIC RALLY

on Friday, August 1st

from 3 till 9 p.m.

The official part will take place between 6.30 and 7.30 when Monsieur C. R. Paravicini, the Swiss Minister, will deliver a patriotic address.

All the side-shows will be in continuous operation from 3 till 9 p.m. and are in charge of members of Swiss Clubs. Mr. J. J. Schneider and other members of the S.M.S. will manage the cocoanut-shies. The "Ball Board," which will appeal to football enthusiasts, is in charge of members of the City Swiss Club, who will also organise a "Treasure Hunt" for the less strenuous members of the Colony. "The Dandy" will give everybody an opportunity to air grievances in a tangible form and is staged by Mr. F. Conrad and other members of the Swiss Choral Society. The children are being catered for by two enterprising ladies who are offering prizes for lucky "Bubbles." The Rifle Shooting on the two 100 yards automatic targets is, of course, under the supervision of the Swiss Rifle Association. A Stop Watch Competition, for 15-jewel lever silver wristlet watch which will be presented by Messrs. Marchand & Jobin. The Community Singing and musical arrangements are in charge of Mr. P. Dick.

HOW TO REACH THE GROUND.

The entrance to the ground is in Edgware Road opposite the Old Welsh Harp at Hendon, through gates marked "Westley Richards' Shooting School." Bus services 142b from Kilburn Park Underground and 60 from the Bank, Charing Cross, Piccadilly Circus, etc., pass the gates, as well as all trams going north in the direction of Edgware. The nearest railway station is "Brent," on the Golders Green tube, which is about 15 minutes' walk from the ground. A private motor coach service will be run from this station between 2.30 and 6.30.
