THE EDITOR'S POST-BAG.

To the Editor, *Swiss Observer*,

FINAL SHOOTING ARRANGEMENTS for the Season 1932.
Dear Sir,

We desire to bring to your notice the following arrangements for the close of the present shooting season:

Shooting will take place on the next three *Sundays*: October 2nd, 9th and 16th. (On *Saturdays* the Range remains closed.)

The following **COMPETITIONS** will be shot off on the aforesaid 3 *Sundays* (and must be definitely finished by the evening of October 16th):

- Challenge Cup Competitions at 300m. and 100 yards:**
- 10 series of 6 shots each with the Swiss Service rifle at the long range. Entrance Fee 5/- and an extra 6 pence for each series. Cost of ammunition 2/- for 10 cartridges.
 - 10 series of 10 shots at the 100 yards range, on paper targets. Entrance Fee 5/- and an extra 6 pence for each series. Cost of ammunition 2/- for 50 rounds.
- The aggregates will count in both cases.

Handicap Competitions.

- 10 series of 6 shots each with the Swiss Service rifle. (Entrance fee 5/- plus 6 pence for each series; cost of ammunition 2/- for 10 cartridges.)
- 10 series of 10 shots on paper targets at the miniature range. (Entrance fee 5/- plus 6 pence for each series; cost of ammunition 2/- for 50 rounds.)

The "handicap" figures of the various Members will be posted on the black board in the Shooting Hut.

In the event of there being sufficient Swiss ammunition left over by Sunday October 16th, the customary "KUNST" and "GLUECK" competitions will take place. Entrance Fee for either of them 2/6 for 3 shots at the long range only on targets with 100 circles. For "Kunst" the aggregate value of the 3 shots will count, and for "Glueck" the value of the *best* shot out of the three.

At present we have about 2,000 Swiss cartridges left.

The Distribution of **PRIZES** will take place on our Shooting Ground on *Sunday evening, October 16th next* and thereafter the Range will remain closed for the winter.

There will be special catering arrangements for the convenience of Members, who are urged to put in an early appearance on each *Sunday*, as dusk will set in early and clocks will be set back one hour next *Saturday* night. The Range will be open from 10 o'clock a.m.

We trust that you will avail yourself of the opportunities offered to show your skill as marksmen and that we may see you carrying off one of the trophies.
