The last representative of the First League came sadly to grief in Lausanne and made an inglorious exit. F.C. Bern continued their recent good work and won a place among the semi-finalists through goals by Gerhold and Townley, both scored in the second half. But the palm must be handed to F.C. Nordstern, whose star must truly be in the ascendant. They led at one time by 2 goals to nil, half-time 2:1. Soon after resuming, Nordstern lost their centre-half, yet the ten men made it 3:1 and whilst Xam bettered Grasshoppers score, and Binder missed a penalty for them, Nordstern hung on grimly to the end. Grasshoppers, the Cupholders, had made their last bow in this year's competition. F.C. Basel once again accounted for Lugano and the lovely town on the Rhine has the privilege of seeing two of its National League clubs in the Semi-Finals. Quite an achievement, when towns like Zurich and Geneva failed to secure a place.

On the 17th March, Switzerland is due in Prague, to play Czecho-Slovakia. The last few disasters in our international games has led to a new team and new tactics; but I fear neither of them are quite "new" enough to warrant much optimism. All the more pleasing would be a success; in fact, even a draw would be quite satisfactory. Well, you never can tell.
