FOREIGN EXCHANGE PROBLEMS.

The Swiss Bank Corporation has published a booklet summarising the restrictions on foreign exchange and their influence on trade. Of the 125 countries mentioned in the summary, less than half are free of foreign exchange restrictions. Many of those whose exchanges are free are subject to trade barriers of other kinds, while clearing agreements are frequently in force. The belief that international trade will never revive until some of the restrictions have been modified can be quite understood. The difficulty is, however, that most of these restrictions were aimed in the first instance at rectifying adverse trade balances, and now there is a general tendency for each country to try to make itself as self-contained as possible. For Great Britain, however, it is essential to export large quantities of goods to other countries in order to obtain the means to pay for the heavy imports of food and raw materials.

"LIEBESMELODIE" AT THE ACADEMY CINEMA.

A very charming and amusing new film in the lightest Viennese style has come to the Academy Cinema for a short run. The opening line of the theme-song — "Die ganze Welt dreht sich um Liebe" — indicates accurately enough the sort of entertainment you are in for. It is an adaptation of Franz Lehars operetta "Clo-Clo" very suitable for the screen. A father and his son after the same opera star! The offspring of course, getting the better of Papa, fine old dago though he may be. Martha Eggerth, so well remembered from the "Unfinished Symphony," is the alluring magnet that falls for the young man, delicately acted by a new-comer Rolf Wanka. Hans Moser of "Maskerade" fame plays a touchingly loyal valet.
