after the Great War, when Greece went to war with Turkey, which refused to recognise the Treaty of Sevres, signed by the allied Powers, these latter offered Greece their mediation, but that was all. And the Greek Army was wiped out without any help. The great Powers remained neutral in that tragic conflict. Should we say to them with Suares : "It is right that the neutrals should suffer?"

And when the Red Sultan, at the end of the last century, had 600,000 Christian Armenians massacred the great Powers of Europe contented themselves with sending him diplomatic notes. None of them thought of emerging from neutrality to defend the Cross of Christ. And shortly after the massacres the Emperor William went to parade in his white cloak before the Holy Sepulchre beneath the guard of the Sultan.
