IN MEMORIAM.

The following is reprinted from the Palmers Green and Southgate Gazette, June 14th:

Mrs. Scheidegger, of 34 The Chine, Grange Park, for many years a keen hospital worker, died in the Wellhouse Hospital, Barnet, on Wednesday, June 5th, after a long illness which, however, ended suddenly.

Mrs. Scheidegger, who was born in Hampstead in 1870, married a gentleman who was naturalised British (formerly Swiss), and their son was killed in the last war while fighting with H.M. Forces.

She had lived in Lightcliffe Road, Palmers Green, for 30 years, prior to removal to Grange Park, and had worked ardently for the League of the Roses, which is associated with the Royal Northern Hospital, since the inception of the league and had been chairman of the Palmers Green division since 1931, working with other ladies who were also in at the beginning, Mrs. Frank Barratt and Mrs. Mabel Johnsen.

Sympathy is expressed for the bereaved husband, and daughter Miss Florence Scheidegger.

The funeral was on Wednesday, the interment in the Great Northern Cemetery following a service in St. John's Church, Palmers Green.

Mrs. Scheidegger had also been a fine worker for the Palmers Green Samaritan Society.
