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- S. P.** — Sorry, we cannot assist you. Until further notice no postage stamps can be imported to or exported from this country. Any of the Zurich commemorative stamps enclosed in the ordinary mail would be confiscated by the censorship — in fact we know this has actually happened. Your only remedy is for you to suggest to your Swiss correspondents to use these stamps freely for franking your letters; they enjoy currency till the end of this year.
- C. S.** — Your suggestion is an excellent one. Our news column — as the title indicates — is collected at random from a variety of sources but there is certainly no reasons why the cantonal items should not be "classified." We think, however, that the seniority rank of the cantons as members of the Confederation is preferable to the official order now generally observed and which has no historical basis. The cantonal news will therefore be printed in future in the following sequence: Uri, Schwytz, Unterwalden, Lucerne, Zurich, Glarus, Zug, Berne, Fribourg, Solothurn, Basle, Schaffhausen, Appenzell, St. Gall, Graubünden, Aargau, Thurgau, Ticino, Vaud, Valais, Neuchâtel and Geneva.
