REV. PATER THOMAS BOOS, O.S.B.

We offer our hearty congratulations to the Rev. P. T. Boos, son of Mr. and Mrs. Jas. Boos, who was ordained priest at Quarr Abbey, Ryde, I.o.W. on 24th August by the R. Rev. Bishop King, of Portsmouth, in the presence of the Abbott and the Community of Quarr. Mr. and Mrs. Boos were also present together with relatives from Switzerland who came over specially to witness this solemn and inspiring ceremony.

While the Rev. P. T. Boos was born in Gt. Britain he retains British and Swiss nationality, was educated in both countries and joined the Quarr Monastery in January, 1941. He is probably the first Anglo-Swiss to be ordained Catholic priest in England.
