Membership of the Society is open to all persons interested in the objects of the Society, subject to election by the Executive Committee.

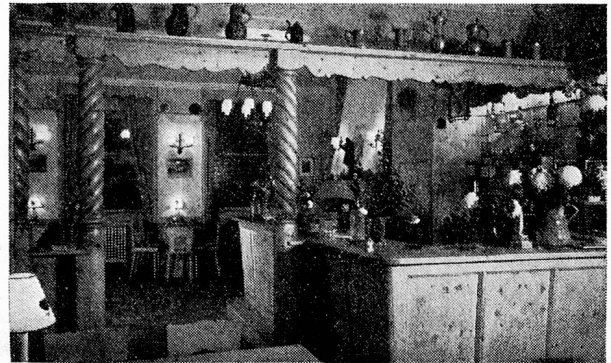
SWISS CLUB, MANCHESTER.
