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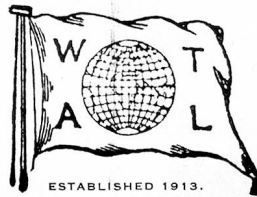
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British Team of Chefs to Visit Swiss "Hospes" Exhibition in Berne

The British national team of chefs which is to demonstrate during British Week (May 20-26), at "Hospes" (the International Cookery Exhibition), Berne, is now complete.

The delegation will number twelve. The two official representatives are Mr. A. C. Juriens, president of the International Academy of Chefs and the Association of Cooks in Great Britain, chef at the Caledonian Club, London, and Mr. W. Bachmann, patron of the Academy, former confectioner and restaurateur, chairman of the "British Week" organising committee.

The team consists of Mr. Arthur Hope, chef at Tregenna Castle Hotel, St. Ives, Cornwall; Mr. A. R.

Cusick, group catering officer, Royal Free Hospital; Mr. E. W. Morrell, chef at the Devonshire Club; Mr. L. Nice, chief instructor at Portsmouth Technical College; Mr. J. A. Potterton, chef patissier at Kunzle's Birmingham; and Mr. F. C. Richbell, larder chef at the Dorchester.

Three chefs will accompany the team as judges, viz. Mr. J. M. Bongers, well-known retired chef and caterer, Mr. E. Kaufeler, chef at the Dorchester, and Mr. L. A. Howe, chef at the Public Schools Club — all members of the jury at Hotelympia 1954.

In addition to the team, the following will enter work as individual exhibitors: Messrs. A. R. Childs, London, A. R. Cusick, London; S. A. Finch, London (exhibit shown on behalf of J. Lyons & Co. Ltd.); A. Hope, St. Ives; R. W. C. Rock, London; F. E. Schur, Ipswich; L. O. Smith as head of Cardiff Technical College Hotel School (students' entries); T. E. Thomson, Leeds; J. H. Waterfield, Church Gresley, Staffs, and E. J. Saggas, Winton, Bournemouth.

The R.A.F. Schools of Cookery will enter 20 assorted exhibits.

The purpose of the British Committee in organising the British Week at Berne is to vindicate the craftsmanship of professional cooks in Great Britain, and to dispel the delusion so prevalent abroad that British cookery falls short of the highest standard of cookery on the continent.
