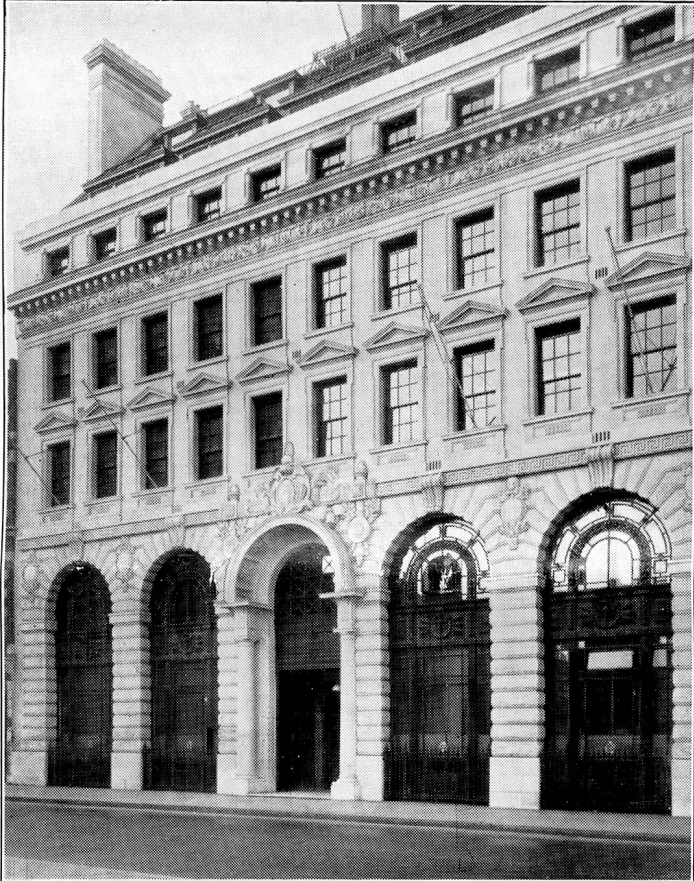

SOIREE MUSICALE.

The Swiss Minister and Madame H. de Torrenté gave a *Soirée Musicale* on Wednesday evening May 5th, at the Goldsmiths Hall, Foster Lane, E.C.2.

The artists which took part in the programme were Edwin Fischer (pianist), Mlle. Marie-Madeleine Tschachtli, and members of the London Philharmonic Orchestra.

There were present members of the Diplomatic Corps, the Government, members of Parliament, the Lord Mayor of London, prominent personalities in all walks of life, and a number of members of the Swiss Colony.

RATIFICATION OF CONVENTION ON SOCIAL INSURANCE.

On April 28th the ratifications of a Convention on social insurance between Switzerland and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland were exchanged at the Foreign Office.

The Convention will enter into force on the 1st of June 1954.

Any questions relating to the Convention should be directed to M. F. Ansermoz at the Swiss Legation. It will come into force in June, 1954, after the administrative agreement which is to regulate its application has been signed.
