DELEGATION FROM BERNESE OBERLAND VISITS BRITAIN.

A delegation of 12 managers of local tourist offices in the Bernese Oberland and publicity managers of the railways in that district visited Great Britain between September 26 and October 1, 1955. The party was led by Mr. Godi Michel, Manager of the Bernese Oberland Tourist Office, Interlaken.

They gave receptions to travel agents in London,

Manchester Bradford and Leeds in appreciation of the collaboration received during the past years and to foster further friendly relations.

At the receptions, two girls in Bernese costume served Swiss wine and Swiss cheese (Hobelkaese) and a colour film about the Bernese Oberland was shown. A yodeller and an accordion player produced Bernese atmosphere.
