LONDON SCAFFOLDERS FLY TO LAGOS.

When Her Majesty the Queen arrives in Lagos on the 28th January, she will drive between crowds of her Nigerian subjects who will be seated on the same kind of Stands as those which lined her Coronation route. A group of twelve Acrow Scaffolders left Heath Row recently for Lagos to supervise the erection of the Stands by African labour. The group, all of whom worked on the Coronation Stands, volunteered to give up part of their Christmas holidays in order to have the Stands ready in time for the Queen's arrival. The contract for the Stands, which will be built of Steel Scaffolding to seat a total of 15,000 people, was won by Acrow (Engineers) Limited in collaboration with their West African distributors, Messrs. John Holt & Co. (Liverpool) Limited.

SWISSAIR EXTENDS WINTER SCHEDULES.

Swissair's current winter time-table period due to expire on April 14th, 1956, has been extended to April 21st, 1956.

Night flights from London to Switzerland, which under the current time-table were due to end on April 9th, have also been extended. Between April 13th and 29th one night flight weekly will operate to Zurich, Geneva and Basle.

To Zurich, it will leave on Sundays, April 15th and 22nd, at 01.40, and on April 29th at 01.35.

To Geneva, it will leave on Fridays, April 13th and 20th, at 23.30 and on Saturday, April 28th, at 00.30.

To Basle, it will leave on Fridays, April 13th and 20th, at 23.05 and on Saturday, April 28th, at 00.05.
