SWISSAIR CHRISTMAS SPECIALS.

To cater for heavy holiday traffic Swissair is operating 30 extra flights from the U.K. to Switzerland between 20th December 1957 and 6th January 1958.

Of these, 21 will go from London to Zurich (including two via Basle), seven from London to Geneva and two from Manchester to Zurich, all in addition to the normal scheduled services.

The extras will include 10 night services at reduced night tourist fares. Peak traffic day will be Saturday 21st December with seven extras, offering together with the scheduled flights a record total of 622 seats to Switzerland.
