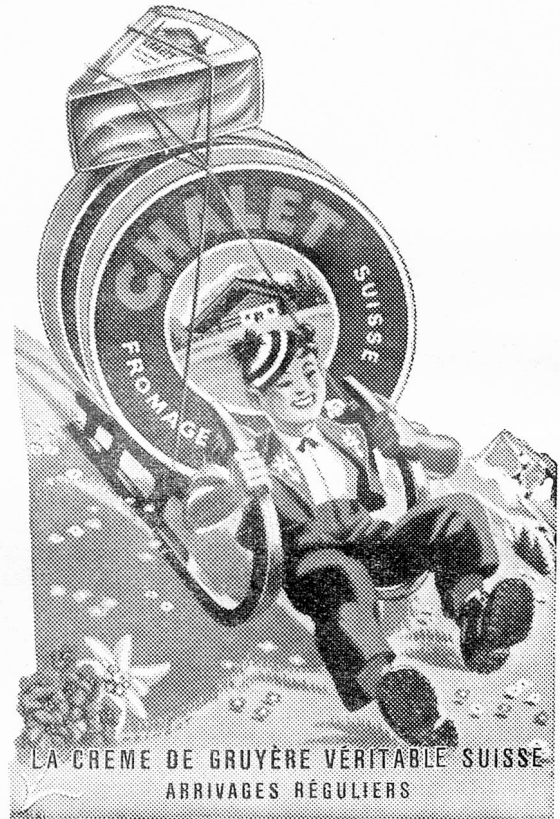

### SWISS CLUB, MANCHESTER.

Only special activities of our Society can be reported in this paper; to report them all would become tedious as perforce many meetings are of an identical character.

During the last few weeks however we have had two interesting events that should be put on record. On November 29th a show of coloured slides taken by our member and friend M. Etienne R. Cottet delighted a very large audience. There is not anything that Mr. Cottet does not know about taking photographs, and it is to his great credit and to our benefit that he does remember his old colleagues from Manchester and lends us these slides. This last show was all about the Swiss Alps and many photographs were of such excellence that a gasp of delight could be heard from many in the audience. The commentary by H. Monney was short but to the point. The same show was given to the Swiss of Leeds on December 4th. Then on December 7th we had the visit of the Swiss pilot Mr. Hermann Geiger, accompanied by his colleague Mr. Max Stampfli. An audience of more than 150 was delighted by his exposition of the technique he has invented for landing on the glaciers, and his subject was illustrated by films and slides of very great beauty. As this lecture was given in London on the previous day and will no doubt be reported in detail in this paper from that part, I need not say anything more here — except that whilst in Manchester Mr. Geiger made a short appearance on the Independent Television programme.
