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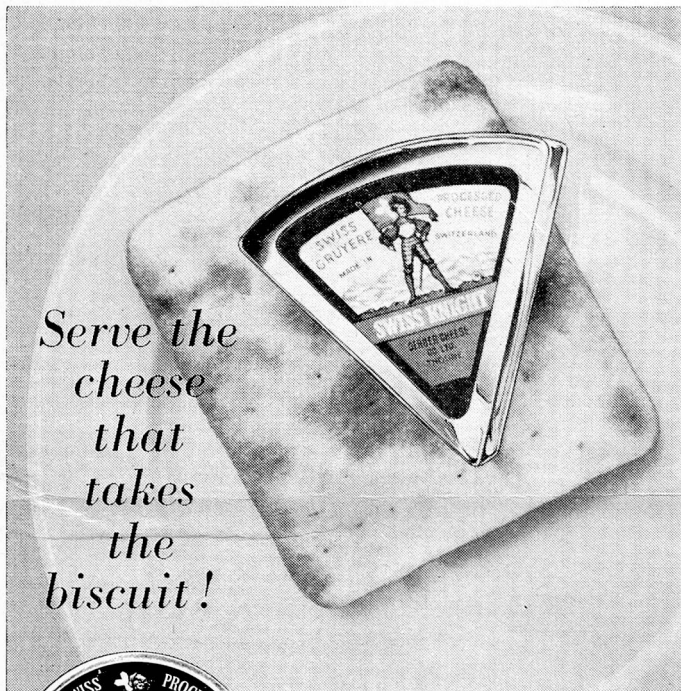
SUCCESS OF SWISS TRANSFORMERS OVERSEAS

The biggest transformer built so far in Switzerland has just been shipped to the Komati hydro-electric power station in South Africa. It is the first of two triphase units built by a big Zurich factory. With an output of 140,000 KVA, this apparatus covers the range of voltages from 12,500 to 300,000 volts. The total weight of the transformer amounts to 165 tons. With an output of one million KVA when completed, the Komati power station will be the biggest in South Africa. [O.S.E.C.]

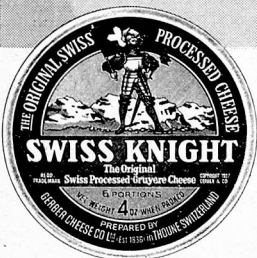
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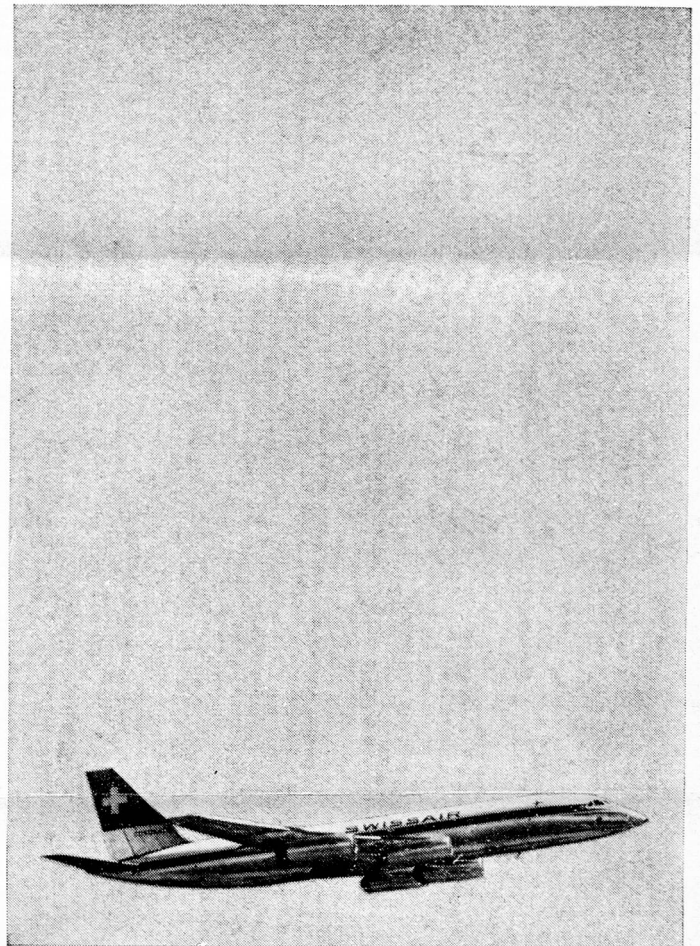


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
