A MULTI-STOREY HOTEL AND A NEW NIGHT CLUB IN ZURICH

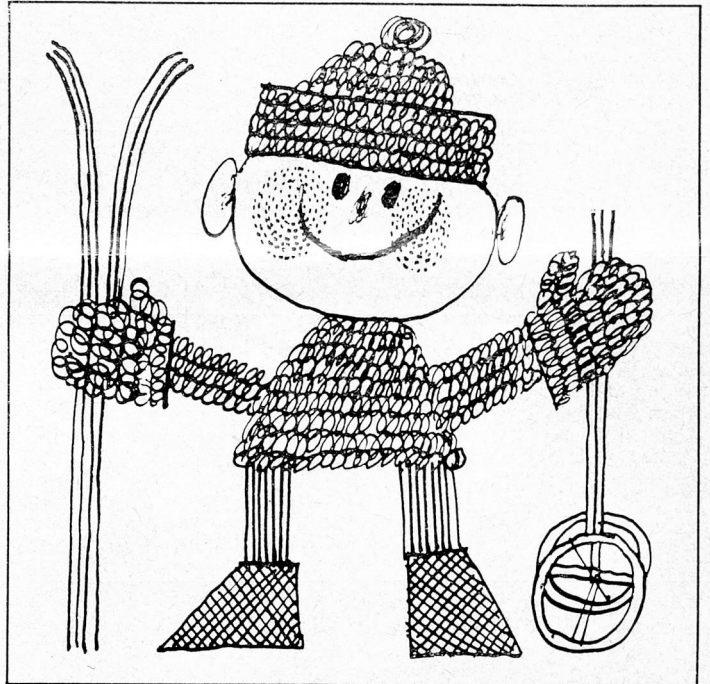
A building permit has just been granted by the city and Canton of Zurich for a hotel to be called "The Delta". The issuing of this permit marks the end of long discussions and negotiations towards finding a practical solution to Zurich's perennial shortage of hotel space. The project, submitted by the Werner Stuecheli architectural office, calls for a first-class commercial hotel with 486 beds, numerous conference rooms, a large conference hall, restaurant space for about 600 people, a snack-bar in the reception hall and a new type of shopping concourse for hotel guests. With garage space for 250 cars, the 23-storey hotel will tower above an already-existing 10-storey office building on Zurich's Badenerstrasse.

"I night club that will reflect in Zurich what is happening in the world" — this is the goal of Hazy Osterwald, 43, world-famous Swiss band leader and showman. To achieve this end he is remodelling the Garden Hall of Zurich's Congress House, transforming it into a night club to be known as "Hazy-Land". Built in western style, to plans by the Munich architect Hans Ley, Hazy-Land will feature rustic wooden tables, long benches and wooden galleries between the two bandstands.
