## NEW SKI RUNS AT MUERREN

This coming Winter, ski enthusiasts from all over the world will find new ski-ing opportunities at Muerren, thanks to the construction of the Stechelberg-Gimmelwald-Muerren-Birg Cablecar (up to 8,830 feet altitude). Continuation of the cablecar system has already been assured. The line is being built according to the most modern methods, and within eighteen months its luxuriously appointed, eighty-place cars will travel up to the peak of the Schilthorn (9,800 ft.). In preparation for the Arlberg-Kandahar Ski Races to be held at Muerren on 11th-13th March 1966, work has already begun at the popular mountain resort on various extra safety measures and improvements to its extensive *pistes*. The almost legendary "Canon Barrel" segment of the run from the Schilthorn Hut (8,025 ft.) down to the Blumental is being smoothed out, to give medium-class skiers a chance to enjoy the pleasures of this unique route.

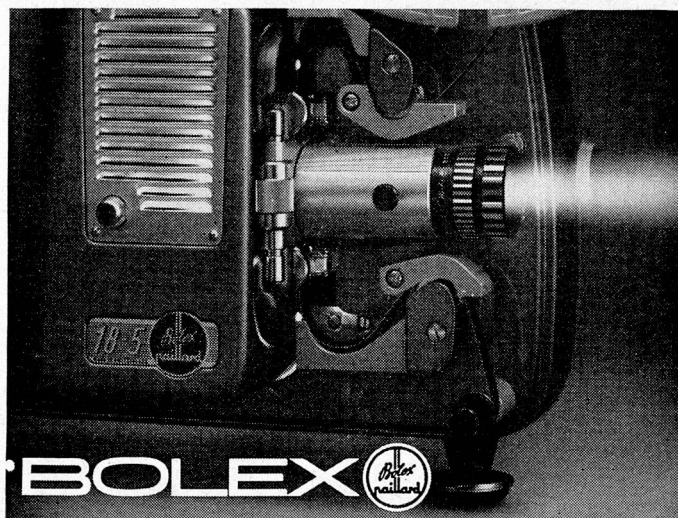

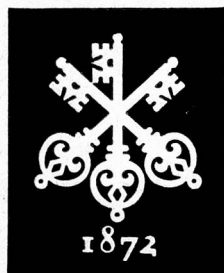
