THE SWISS CIGARETTE INDUSTRY

In 1964, the production of cigarettes in Switzerland went up by 4.5% from 15,299 pieces in 1963 to 15,986 last year. The increase the previous year had been 10% over 1962. Under half the cigarettes produced were of the one-franc-packet variety. The sale of more expensive types, however, is on the increase. The American kind of cigarette has become more and more popular, whereas cigarettes of the English and oriental types have been lost ground.
