SWISS AIRPORT TAX VOUCHERS

U.K. travellers to Switzerland can now pay the Swiss airport tax in advance in sterling by buying vouchers from Swissair offices. The face values of the vouchers are four Swiss francs for Basle and five francs for Berne, Geneva and Zurich. They are being sold at 7s. and 8s. 6. respectively.

The new facility is additional to the advance sale in sterling by Swissair offices of coach tickets for transport between Swiss airports and town terminals. They cost 3s. 6d. single for Geneva and 5s. single for Basle and Zurich. Their local values are two and three Swiss francs respectively.

A FINE OLD SWISS ASTRONOMICAL CLOCK RETURNS HOME


The Swiss National Museum recently purchased a fine astronomical clock of Swiss origin, which had for a long time formed part of British collections. It is a rare collector's piece, a little over 19 in. high, octagonal in shape, and with a wooden dial set with tortoise-shell and pewter. In the centre, a painted copper plate has a number of dials and windows in silver and brass indicating the hours and half-hours, the days of the week, the date, the phases and age of the moon, the planets, the signs of the zodiac, the length of the day and night. This extremely elegant clock with a richly worked brass movement was made about 1670 by Beat Jakob Brandenburg of Zug.
