SWISS CULTURAL WEEK IN PARIS

A most successful Swiss Cultural Week took place in Paris from 13th to 23rd January. It was held at the "Maison Internationale" (*Cité internationale de l'Université de Paris*) under the patronage of the Swiss Ambassador, Monsieur Agostino Soldati, and was arranged by the residents of the *Fondation Suisse* and the *Groupe d'études helvétiques de Paris*. There was a Swiss poster exhibition and a show by Swiss graphic artists living in Paris. Lectures were organised on, amongst others, Le Corbusier, J. J. Rousseau, Friedrich Dürrenmatt, and one talk was given on "L'apport de la Suisse Romande à la civilisation d'expression française". Various Swiss films were shown, amongst them "Quand nous étions petits enfants" and "Siamo Italiani".

The *Groupe d'études helvétiques de Paris* held their general meeting during the Swiss week. It has at present thirty-seven members, and the work of the first two years may be considered as very successful.
