AN INVALUABLE LITTLE APPLIANCE

The stripping of electrical wires is a difficult and tiresome job when it has to be repeated hundreds and hundreds of times as in certain industries. An electro-technical firm in Zurich has invented an appliance for the rapid and neat removal of insulation from all standard insulated round and stranded wires up to a diameter of 9 mm. The Isomap, equipped with five cutting heads and a potentiometer, strips all kinds of wire automatically, at adjustable speeds, over a preset length or otherwise, at the same time automatically retwisting the end of the stripped wire, thus saving considerable time. This instrument, completely satisfying all technical requirements, can be supplied with various accessories rationalizing its use, such as in particu-

lar a stand, combined with a foot pedal control giving the operator great manual freedom, which is so important when work has to be carried out in large batches. [O.S.E.C.]

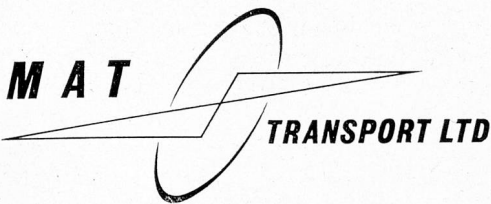

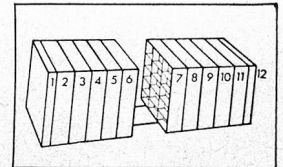
