The London Group of the Nouvelle Société Helvétique have organised a Discussion and Social Evening on Thursday, 19th September. The Rev. Father P. Bossard, Consul F. Adams and Mrs. M. Meier will give their impressions of the recent Assembly of the Swiss Abroad in Schaffhausen. Various points arising will be dealt with. Members will have a chance of bringing up their own questions for discussion. It was felt that an informal gathering of this nature would be an excellent beginning of the new season which, as usual, should bring a few good lectures on various topics of interest.

The programme includes piano works by Liszt, Chopin and Schumann, songs by Schubert, Haendel, Mozart, Schumann and Wolf and a cantata by Schuetz, also a sonata for recorder and continuo by Haendel.

The artists taking part are Lili Bucherer (soprano), Mariann Meier (alto), Kenneth Causton (tenor), Uli Stefan (bass), Elisabeth Schubarth (Recorder), Dennis Becher (Oboe) and Lennart Rabes (piano).

Lili Bucherer studied music in Basle with Alice Giroud, Erika Frauscher and GMD Gottfried Becker, and with Roy Henderson in London. She is very well known in Switzerland (Basle, Lucerne, Solothurn), as well as in England. She has also sung in Scotland and Ireland. Her speciality are *Lieder*, but she has appeared in opera and oratorio.

Mariann Meier had private tuition with Walter Sterk in Basle and was a member of the Sterk'sche Privatchor.

Kenneth Causton studied at the Guildhall School of Music with Henry Wendon, Norman Walker and Alexander Young. He is well known for his *Lieder* interpretations and has appeared in oratorio. He frequently sings in London as well as in the provinces. He has performed with Covent Garden and with Janet Baker.

Uli Stefan studied at the Schola Basiliensis and with H. M. Linde. He is a member of the "Evangelische Singgemeinde".

Elisabeth Schubarth had musical tuition at the Schola Basiliensis and with Marianne Luethi and Janine Lehmann.

Dennis Becher had private tuition with Walter Jenke at Bryanston School. He has played with various chamber music groups.

Lennart Rabes studied in Sweden, Switzerland, Italy, Holland, Paris and London with artists as Erica Cavallo, Bela Siki, Magda Tagliaferro and Louis Kentner as a pianist, and with Carl von Garaguly, Paul van Kempen, Willem van Otterloo and Sir Adrian Boult in conducting. He is very well known on the Continent where he has recorded for many radio stations and has given many concerts. He has also given recitals in England.
