NEWS FROM THE SWISS EMBASSY

The Youth Service of the Secretariat for the Swiss Abroad is again organising three ski-camps for young Swiss (15-24 years of age) living abroad. The camps will take place:

1. From 26th December, 1974, to 4th January, 1975, in Sedrun/GR;
2. From 29th March, to 8th April, 1975, in Melchsee Frutt (Central Switzerland);
