Queen's Award for Acrow

It was announced on 21st April, 1976, that Acrow Ltd, the Acrow Group Holding Company, had been conferred the Queen's Award for Export Achievement (1976).

Exports for the Group have more than doubled over the last three years to reach £32½ million, representing well over half of total production.

Commenting, Mr. Bill Jack, managing director of Acrow Ltd, said today:

"We are very honoured to have received this Award and proud of all 10,000 employees within the Group who contributed to this achievement.

Indications are that Acrow Group exports are currently topping the £50 million mark."
