# NEW AGREEMENT BETWEEN SWISSAIR AND OLYMPIC

Swissair and Olympic Airways have signed an agreement covering their co-operation in the re-organisation and personnel training of the Greek carrier including the introduction and implementation of modern management and operations methods. The accord was signed in Athens by Swissair's president Armin Baltensweiler.

The re-organisation of Olympic Airways will be carried out by its own staff for whom Swissair will provide all relevant information and advice. Plans include provision for the training of Olympic middle and lower management personnel at Swissair facilities. On their return to Greece these staff members will comprise the initial nucleus to train their colleagues.

Olympic Airways' re-organisation will be supervised by a team of Swissair experts under the direction of the company's first executive vice-president, Adolphe Gehrigier.

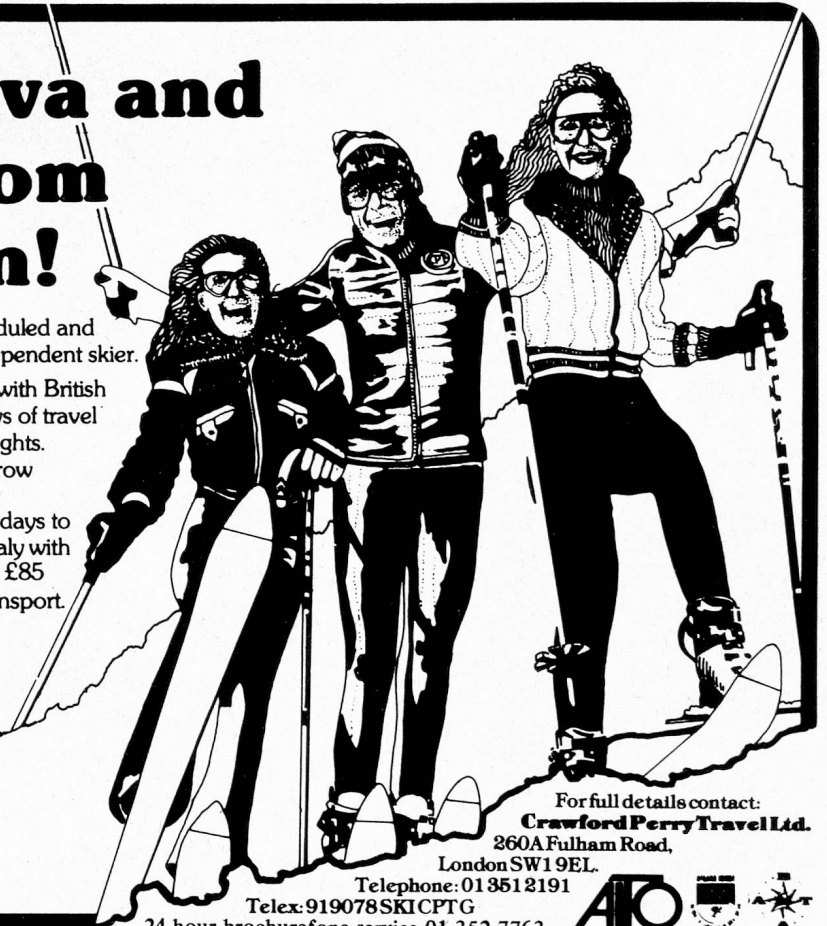
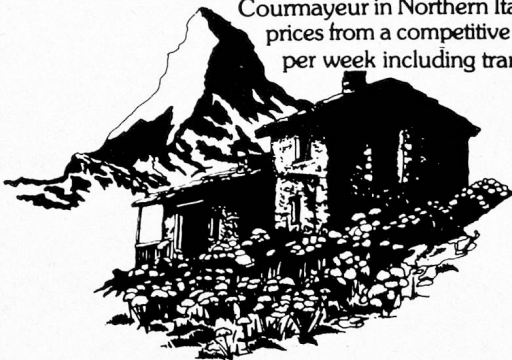
