THE ST. MORITZ FOLKLORE GROUP AT THE FOLKESTONE INTERNATIONAL FOLKLORE FESTIVAL

The St. Moritz Folklore Group is well known for its travel activities. Following an invitation to Karlsruhe (Germany) at the beginning of June, the

group represented Switzerland in England from 23rd to 26th June at the International Folklore Festival in Folkestone.

The group consists of one alphorn blower, 16 dancers and singers (leader: Dr. Adolph Haeberli), three musicians (one accordion, one "Swiss accordion", one con-trabass).

The St. Moritz Folklore Group do not only perform Swiss dances. During the winter season it has become almost a tradition that they organise Scottish Country Dancing evenings which are attended internationally, mainly by members of the St. Moritz Tobogganing Club (Cresta), the Combined Services Winter Sports Association and the Ski Club of Great Britain.
