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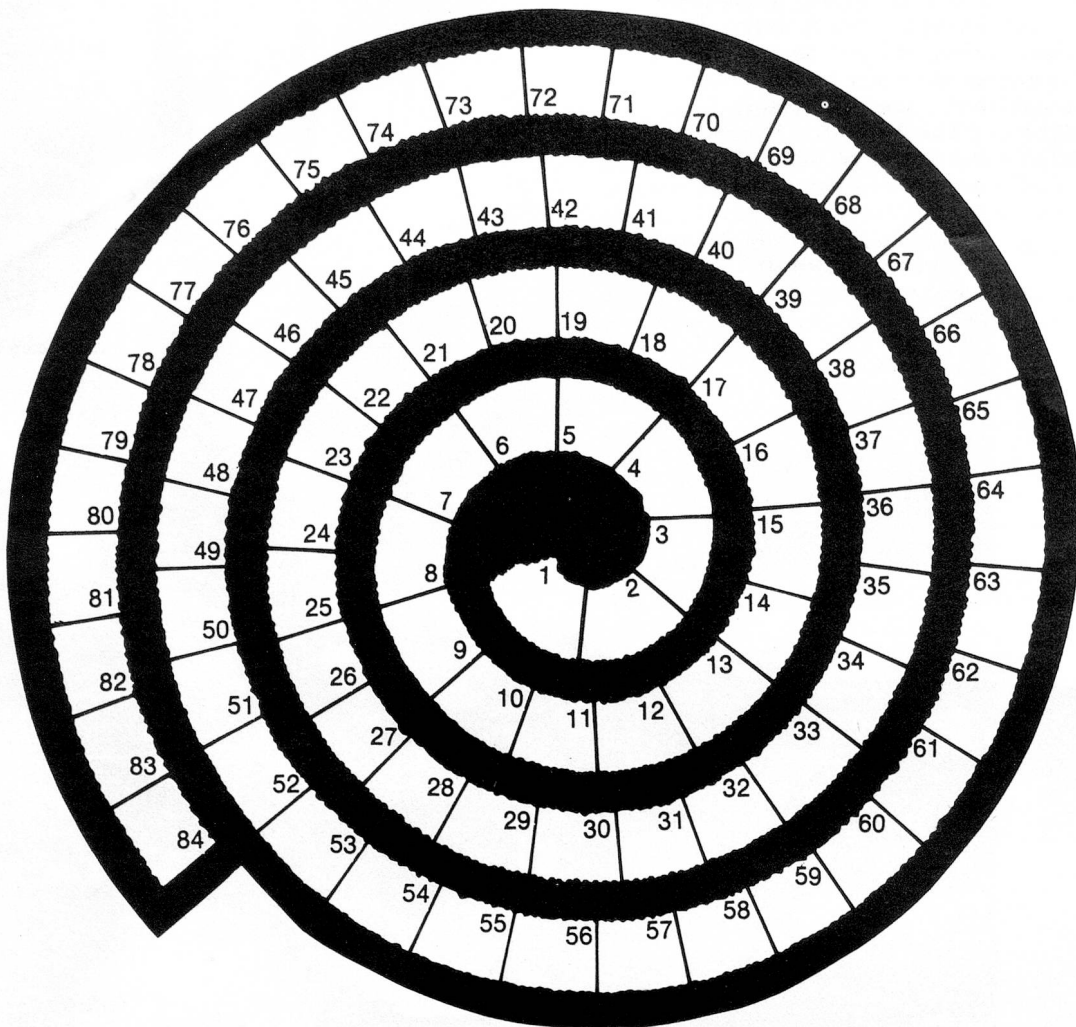
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Take a turn at the Swiss Roll

of the next word.

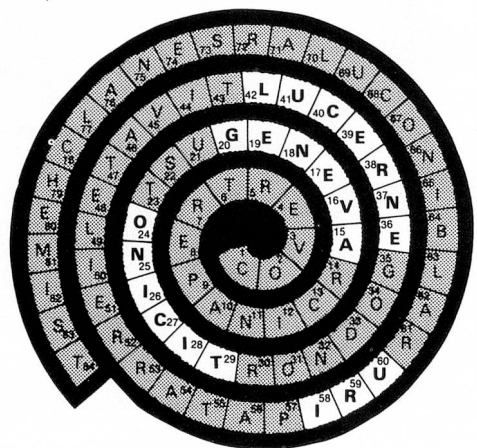
If your solution is correct you will find that, hidden somewhere in the REVERSE reading, are the names of three places in Switzerland.
