Lausanne – a seat of learning

MOST of the Swiss language schools are located in Lausanne, equally well known as a centre for scholars as for tourists.

The objective of these schools is to achieve both a written and spoken facility in French that will enable the students to use their knowledge at a scholastic or professional level, as well as to communicate at an everyday level

Their teaching methods take

the fullest advantage of modern audiovisual aids in conjunction with the traditional system. Small classes, conducted by qualified teachers, promote individual attention, taking into account the aptitudes of each person. Lessons take place in the mornings from 8am to 12 noon.

The schools prepare for the official diplomas of the Alliance Française from Paris.

Students of any nationality or


age group — from 16 years upwards — are eligible for enrolment

As these language courses are given in day schools, it permits the students to become ac-quainted with local Swiss people at their boarding houses and during their leisure hours.

From time to time schools organise optional excursions to other towns, to archeological or artistic sites and monuments, and winter sports ski trips.


