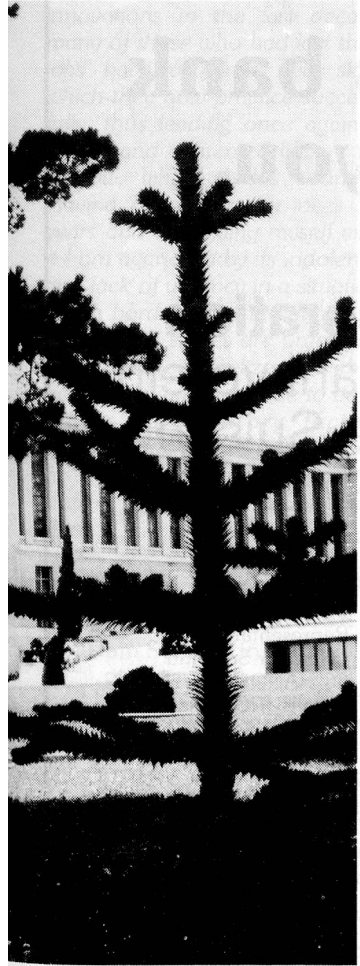
### Package holidays in Geneva

THE Swiss Post Office has issued seven new multi-coloured postage stamps. Three of the stamps – depicting the old town hall of Stans and the cantonal seals of Fribourg and Solothurn – commemorate the 500th anniversary of the historic Convention of Stans and the entry of the two cantons into the Swiss Confederation.

The four other stamps mark this year's opening of Switzerland's first national museum of science and technology, the Technorama in Winterthur, the recently completed restoration of St. Peter's Cathedral in Geneva, and the 50th anniversaries of Switzerland's internationally-recognised "cross-bow" seal of quality and the Swiss Association of Youth Organisations.

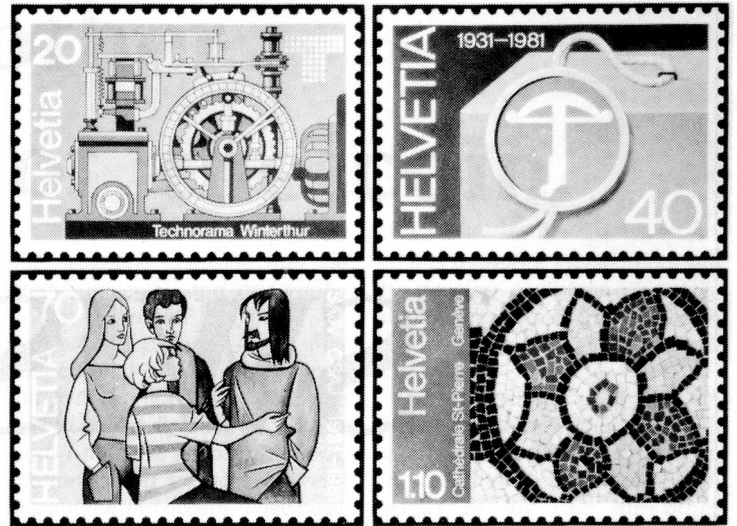
### Geneva motor show
