Kuoni family offer

KUONI has introduced what it believes in a unique family holiday programme in its second summer Switzerland brochure.

Based in Lenzerheide, children are grouped together for action days supervised by trained helpers free of charge.

Also new are luxury coach tours from Manchester and London from £167 a week to Interlaken and £186 to Lucerne.

The operator sold more than 6,000 holidays in its first Switzerland burst last year and for 1984 has increased capacity by 25 per cent. It claims that 92 per cent of its "first" clients said they would travel to the country with Kuoni again.

Extras include two weeks for the price of one in 14 resorts; a

fixed £99 for children under 12, irrespective of the holiday duration, throughout the summer; no single room supplements; half-price travel on Swiss rail; car hire with Avis at £12 a day; and free sports in some resorts.
