Members will see an advert in this journal from the Dampfbahn Furka Bergstreke AG, which is doing valient work on the restoration of the line over the Furka via Gletch and Tiefenbach. The proposal is to open this rack rail line to traffic hauled by steam locomotives. A loco type HG2/3 "Weisshorn", built by SLM in 1902, has been donated by the city of CHUR for operation on the line from June 1989. Full details of the membership fee and the aspirations of the FB Society are available from the gentleman named in the advert.
