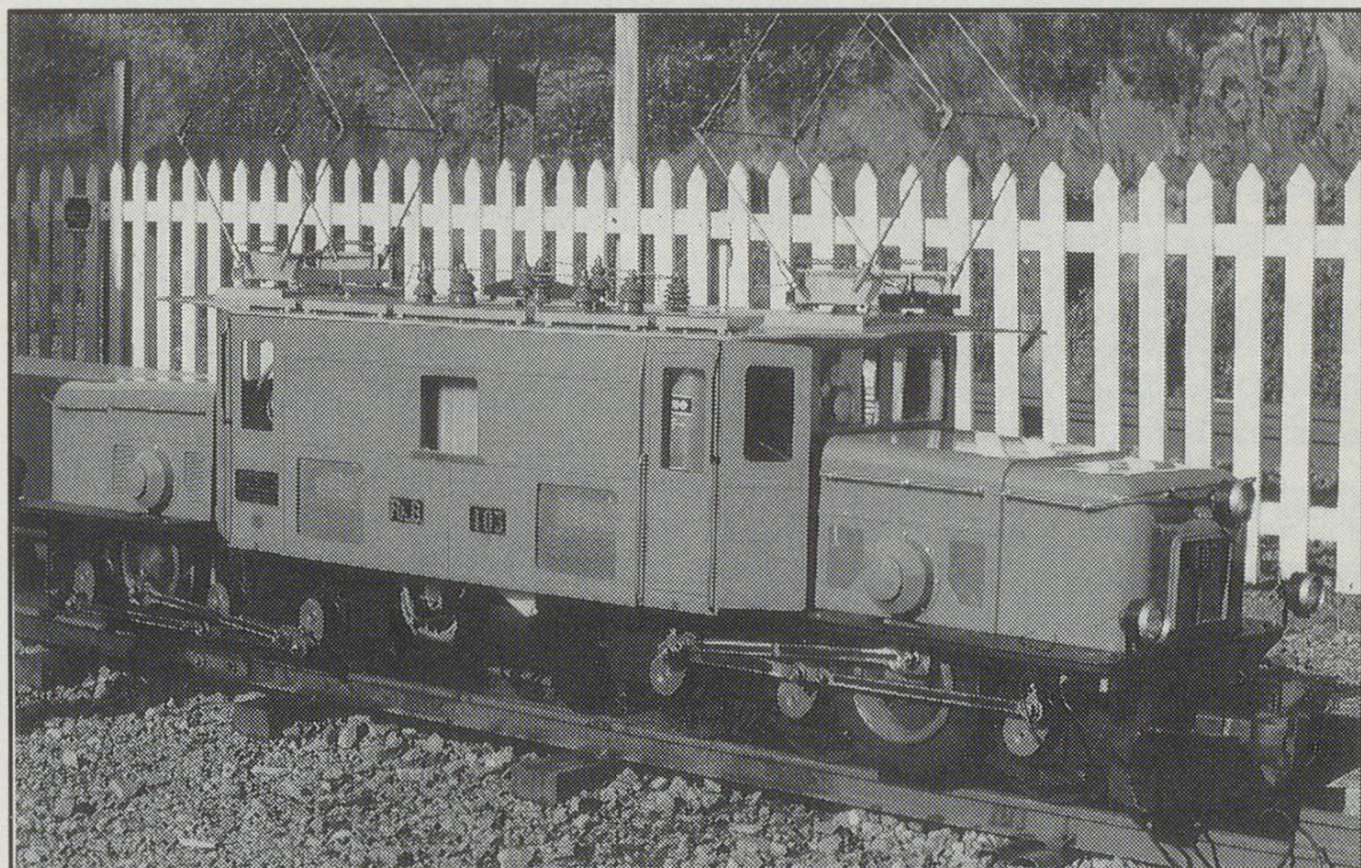

MINIATURE RAILWAYS

For our first advertisement in Swiss Express, I should like to introduce one of our 1987 productions: RhB Locomotive Ge6/6¹ No 403.



Pfeifferbahn built the mechanical parts and supplied the electronic control gear. The customer built the bodywork from wood (except the two bonnets, for which he obtained the services of a maker of replica armour!) Finally, all the electrics were assembled and tested on site by a friend of the customer.

Brief specification of this 1/5th. scale 'Baby Krok' is: Four 1 HP permanent magnet motors drive the wheels through the flywheels and rods as per the prototype; current is supplied from a 36 volt 'semi-traction' battery, air brakes are fitted (we know the RhB uses Vacuum brakes!) as well as an air powered whistle, also provided is a recording on a chip of the station bells from the RhB which operate just as the locomotive is about to depart.

If you are interested in having your own 7¼ inch gauge railway, particularly an electric one, please send me an s.a.e. stating your interest. We have now been in the business for over 13 years. Now being built is an RhB Ge4/4^{II} No 615. Don Fifer. SRS. No.J88
