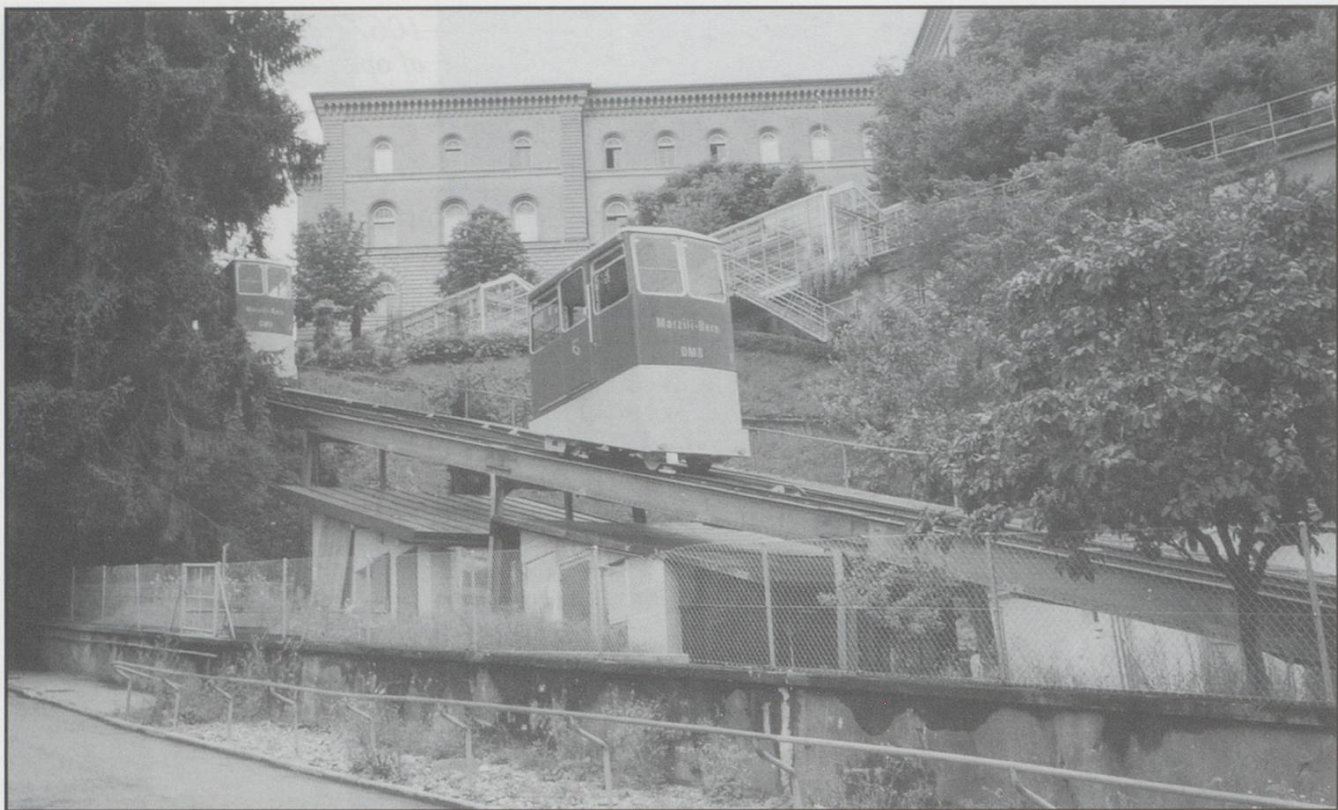

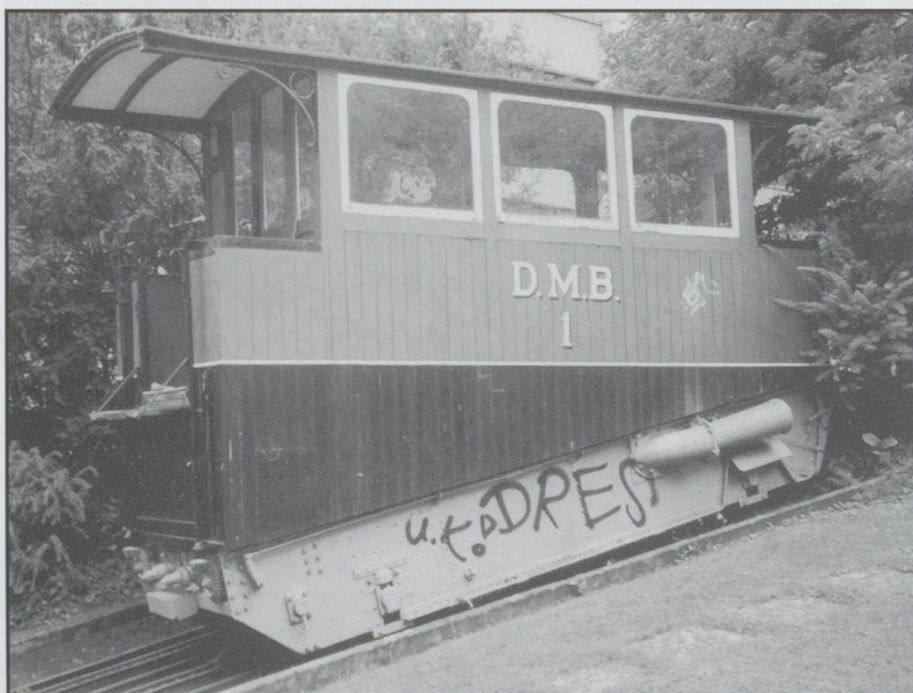
The two modern (1974) electric cars entering the passing loop.

SMALL BUT SIGNIFICANT

I enclose a couple of photos taken by my wife in July 2001 when, quite by chance we came upon the Marzili - Bern Funicular (DMB) which climbs from the top of Marzilistrasse, alongside the road named Bundesrain, up to the Bundesterrace at the rear of the Parliament buildings. According to the

Kursbuch table no. 2350 the funicular climbs an altitude of 32 metres in its length of 105 metres in a journey time of one minute and so we wonder if this is the shortest funicular in Switzerland?
