# 100 YEARS OF THE POSTAUTO - 100 YEARS OF

Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> May 2006 was a very special day in the history of the PostBus which celebrated its 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary at Aarberg, The first route ran between Bern and Detligen and a procession of mostly preserved postbuses travelled from Detligen to Aarberg.

So woven into the fabric of Swiss life is the Postbus that the event was attended by the Federal President, Mortiz Leuenberger together with Benedikt Weibel, retiring Chief Executive of SBB, and the head of the Post Office Ulrich Gygi. They jointly inaugurated an SBB 460 in PostAuto livery. Some pictures from the event follow.
