## Grand Steamer Event on the Vierwaldstättersee

The flagship of the SGV, the steam paddle ship "Stadt Luzern", will celebrate her 80th birthday in 2008. "Die Stadt" ("The City"), as their ship is lovingly called, is the youngest Swiss paddle steamer and with its noble, maritime look she is in a class by herself.

On Saturday, April 19th, 2008 the SGV will celebrate the birthday of "Stadt Luzern" and her four sister steamers in a festive parade.
