MODELLING NEWS

Peter Marriott looks at an assortment of goodies for those of us who model Swiss railways

The German company Brawa produce a modern Swiss Telecom (Swisscom) public telephone box in HO scale. The box is illuminated and nicely modelled with clear plastic windows and excellent interior detail. In the UK it is available from Brawa dealers. The phone box costs around £8.

The number of liveries in which the Liliput SBB Schüttgutwagens are produced is expanding in HO scale. These recent models of Epoch IV/V wagons have good detail on the bodies, super smooth running characteristics and finely produced markings on the bodies. The set with the Vectro recycling wagons has one yellow vehicle and one green one. As usual I found these Liliput models to be well packaged. Individual wagons retail at around £15.

Rietze make a huge number of model road vehicles. Today they are the world's leading manufacturer of coaches and buses in scale 1:87. Their main catalogue runs to about 52 pages but in addition every few months they produce a specials leaflet. Winco usually stock Swiss and Austrian buses and coaches but are happy to order items for customers. Small Post Buses (such as depicted in this article) retail at around £8. Larger buses and coaches range from around £15 upwards.
