I will visit this establishment in September to see what can be organised. For the BLS 100 event I will let you book your own Hotel in the area, but when contacting Anna at the Grischuna to book your room please mention you are a part of the SRS party. Most of you will know that single room accommodation in the Grischuna is limited, so book early. As before, a degree of physical fitness will be required for this trip and of course you will need to organise your own travel arrangements and appropriate insurance.
