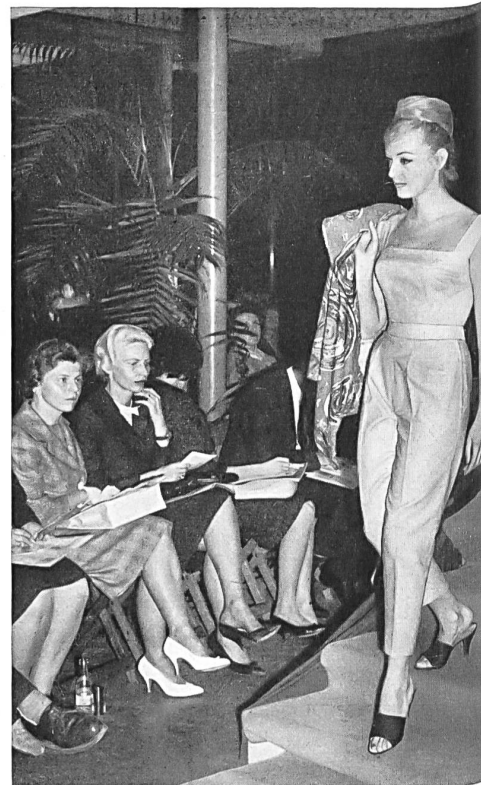

Swiss Cotton Weeks 1960

This year the St. Gall Office for the Promotion of the Swiss Cotton and Embroidery Industries once again organised a number of their traditional "cotton weeks" for the purpose of popularising this fibre throughout Switzerland. Included in the campaign was a series of fashion parades showing models made with embroideries and fabrics of St. Gall, to be held in 12 Swiss towns and organised each time in collaboration with the local retail trade. The tour started in Zurich, in the Zoological Gardens, with a special display put on for journalists. This first, highly successful fashion parade showing some sixty models made by Swiss couturiers and ready-to-wear manufacturers was held in the original if somewhat unusual setting of the new monkey house. Opposite we reproduce some of the models shown on this occasion.

This presentation was preceded by a cocktail party and press conference given in the new bird house by the international organisation Felisol. Our readers know that the yellow and blue Felisol label (Regd. trade mark) guarantees the colour fastness of the fabrics
