VARIED FIELD OF USE FOR BERBER CARPETS

For the Melchnau Carpet Factory Co. Ltd., which has been going strong for over fifty years now, the manufacture of rustic Berber-style wall-to-wall carpeting is part of a long-standing tradition in a programme that is always in perfect keeping with the latest market trends. The firm's present Berber range comprises 13 different qualities, 7 of them with a compact PVC foam back, all woven in a 420 cm width. The appearance varies from one style to another, but one thing that never changes is the Woolmark quality guaranteeing the use of high quality pure new wool yarns.

"Melflor" is a cut pile article. "Melberino Twin", with its attractive 8-strand designs, has a matching plain version "Melberino". "Melrelief", as its name indicates, has a marked relief effect, in the modern rustic style, giving a warm personal look to any room in which it is used. This Berber wall-to-wall carpeting is also ideal for covering walls and ceilings. "Melcord" is the name given to an article with woven designs, whose rustic character is in keeping with current trends and whose design, thanks to the weaving process used, continues to remain visible even after heavy use. The collection is very successfully completed by the "Melsuper" line, which is practically the only Berber guaranteed to retain its depth and warmth in spite of heavy wear on stairs or due to the passage of invalids' wheelchairs.
