Certificate Course in Applied Linguistics and the Teaching of English

Courses begin in October, January and April. Each course consists of ten weeks' full-time study.

Course Content

The Certificate scheme offers intensive study of the theoretical bases of English language teaching, together with an opportunity for work relating theory to practice. All candidates follow courses in:

- a) the theoretical bases of applied linguistics;
- b) the psychological bases of teaching English as a foreign language;
- c) descriptions of English; and
- d) English language teaching methodology.

In addition, candidates choose one of the following Practical Class options: Syllabus Design; Technical Aids; Teacher Training; and Evaluation.

Entrance Qualifications

This scheme is primarily intended for foreign teachers who are university graduates, or for people who are taking a degree course in English (preferably with an Education component) with the intention of becoming teachers of English as a foreign language, and who are nearing the end of their course. It may also be possible to accept non-graduate serving teachers of English as a foreign language, if their previous academic record and teaching experience is considered suitable.

Fees

£ 135 per ten-week course.
